## THE JOURNEY

The Journey: Pinot Noir vineyards in Monterey County's Arroyo Grande region contribute most of the fruit for this wine, with the remaining Pinot Noir coming from the cooler Santa Barbara region. These vines produce a wine that is medium-bodied with soft tannins and classic Pinot Noir aromas of red fruit, violet, rose petal and earthy mushroom. The color is a brilliant, deep garnet red with a slight purple tint. The flavors of this wine were enhanced by aging in seasoned American oak, a bold twist on the usual method for aging Pinot Noir.

## THE WINE

Made with a uniquely American perspective, 1000 Stories is crafted to push boundaries. Our bold Pinot Noir brings distinct notes of wild cherry, black raspberry, vanilla and coconut oil. These deepen alongside hints of earth and allspice from seasoned American oak—a boldly spirited pursuit of doing things differently.
