THE WINE

For this 2021 vintage, winemaker Sebastian Donoso selected Cabernet Sauvignon grapes primarily from renowned vineyards in Lodi California. This medium-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon exudes classic Cabernet aromas—beautiful dark cherry, blueberry, prune, and tobacco, a firm tannin structure, and a brilliant dark mahogany red with a slight purple color. The wine also expresses subtle notes of dried herb and caramel, signature bourbon barrel characteristics brought on by our unique barrel ageing process. The layered flavor profile is accentuated by structure and a long finish.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Aged in American and French oak, then finished off in bourbon barrels Pairs best with cast iron ribeye steak with roasted veggies or Provencal beef stew
